




#### Poggio Conte Hiking Tour

The hermitage of Poggio Conte is one of the most magical places around can find, once upon a time, land on the border between Tuscany and Lazio of customs between the Papal State and the Grand Duchy of Tuscany. The origins of the hermitage are lost in time, around the year 1000 in fact there are numerous places of retreat and prayer that were created in these areas, but Poggio Conte still has an incredible charm today envelops anyone who arrives in this place! The path winds along the course of the Fiora river, it is still immersed in a place uninhabited and wild as when it was built and as then there are no signs to find the site, you have to rely on the indications from those who have already been there and face the journey with great vicinity in the rock and what remains of the original monastic settlement together with some chamber tombs and the presence of a roaring waterfall in a natural amphitheatre marvelous. Once we arrive at the hermitage we will take a short tour to visit it and at the foot of the waterfall we will have a small aperitif

# Super Tuscan Wine Experience Private Tour Bolgheri

Bolgheri wine history is as young as extraordinary, and its wines have managed to conquer the first places in the world rankings in a very short time, "challenging" the famous Doc and Docg. It will be an experience to be enjoyed pedaling along the small streets of the countryside, from the sea to the hills, and up and down between vineyards, panoramas of the Tuscan coast and the island of Elba on the horizon, Capraia and on the clearest days Corsica.

During our journey we will visit some of the most important wineries in the area, where we will have the opportunity to visit their cellars and taste their wines, including the Super Tuscan.

Lunch break at the wine shop of Tenuta San Guido, where we can taste the famous Sassicaia. You cannot miss visiting the small village of Bolgheri that we will reach by riding along the famous avenue of cypresses, also mentioned by poets.



#### Le Mortelle -Antinori

Le Mortelle is located in the heart of the Tuscan Maremma, a few kilometers from Castiglione della Pescaia (GR),

in an extraordinary and fascinating position both for nature and for the history of the places that surround it.

The estate, owned by the Antinori family, covers 270 hectares, 170 of which are dedicated to vines.

The underground cellar, located on the top of the hill, is in perfect harmony with the surrounding countryside.

On the horizon, the sea of Maremma and the island of Giglio.

Monteverro lies at the foot of the small medieval town of Capalbio on the southern edge of Tuscany in Maremma, a region well-known for its originality and tradition.

The vineyard estate is situated in proximity of the coast and is characterized by its unusual slopes on stony, red clay soil. But it is also the people who make Monteverro so unique.

#### Capalbio Private Tour

This tour will take us to visit Monteverro, located near the village of Capalbio, where we will discover how their wines are born, we will then be taken to the vineyards, to the cellar and we will taste their wines with a meat or fish-based lunch.

In the afternoon we will visit the splendid Tarot Garden created by the French-American artist Niki de Saint Phalle, populated by statues inspired by the major tarot characters.

Before returning to the hotel, we will stop at a small distillery, a family business born in the late 1950s that has managed to keep tradition and craftsmanship intact. Here too we will have the opportunity to visit the distillery and taste their spirits and liqueurs.



## Horse Riding Experience

The horse ride starts in the southern area of Maremma park, near Talamone, another Maremma jewel.

It is a 2-hour ride in the regional park.

Paths are a mix of different scenery, through
the coastal Mediterranean Scrub woods with
low vegetation areas, dirt roads and centuriesold olive groves.

Vegetation is typical of the Mediterranean scrub with shrub and wooded areas of holm oaks, cork oaks, strawberry bushes, rosemary. You are likely to meet deers, wild boars and other wild animals.

We will start on flat terrain, in the older area of the farm, to get familiar with your new friend, for then moving to the Uccellina's Mountains. You will be able to enjoy the wonderful sight of Monte Argentario and Orbetello.





#### Boat Excursion

A fun day at sea: Spend a day sailing or motorboting around the Tuscan archipelago.

Visit the Islands of Giglio and Giannutri and experience their pristine coastline, discover hidden coves, and swim in crystal-clear waters.



#### Corsini Botanical Gardens
