A reflection of *the French Riviera* and its treasures

Perched above Roquebrune-Cap-Martin, The Maybourne Riviera opens itself to the Mediterranean and the Principality of Monaco, which the hotel embraces from its lofty vantage point.



At the crossroads of the French Riviera and the Italian coast, where the road winds between land and sea, its silhouette stands out like an architectural vessel. A destination in its own right, embodying the essence and splendour of the Côte d'Azur.



A historic *and glamorous* heritage

One must wind through the mountain passes to discover the original building of The Maybourne Riviera, dating back to the 19th century. Perched above Roquebrune-Cap-Martin, the hotel's historic structure - once a quaint tea salon - stretches its lines over three hundred metres above the sea. Originally built in 1870, the eagle's nest-like structure on stilts clings to the rocky outcrop at the crossroads of the Riviera, the Italian coast, and the Principality. Nestled on the cliffside, the original wooden architecture was transformed into a hotel for the first time in the 1920s. The 1950s ushered

in a new chapter as the building evolved into a contemporary design, with balconies embracing the Mediterranean. In 1978, industrialist Max Grundig took over the hotel, renaming it Vista Palace for the next thirty years. In 2014, it joined the prestigious Maybourne group, a rapidly expanding collection that includes London's iconic hotels: Claridge's, The Connaught, The Berkeley, The Emory, as well as a property in Beverly Hills.

Its pristine lines, a flagship between land and sea - both mineral and graphic - seem timeless, as if it has always been there since reopening its doors in 2021.

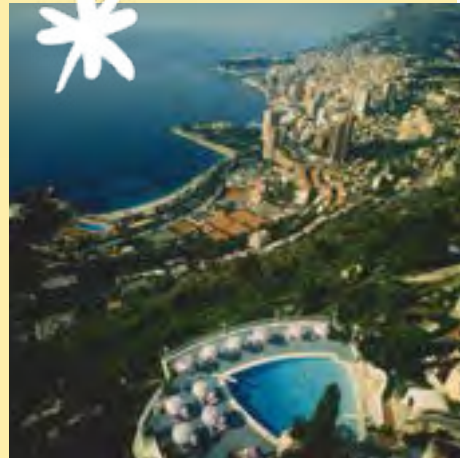

Jean-Michel Wilmotte's creation is an architectural vessel moored to the rock, a haven that echoes the historic lighthouse of the Mediterranean more than a century after its birth. This epicurean art of living has resonated within the building since the golden age of the Côte d'Azur, when cinema and music icons were its distinguished guests. Elizabeth Taylor and Richard Burton, as well as the singer Frank Sinatra, were regulars, captivated by this rare tête-à-tête with the horizon.

The Côte d'Azur has long drawn a myriad of artists and celebrities, sparking an unparalleled creative energy that gave rise to an artistic heritage shaped by Henri Matisse and Pablo Picasso. Glamorous soirées enlivened the social scene, with the hotel playing a starring role. Like a glass cloud over the sea, The Maybourne Riviera still breathes the atmosphere of a past rich in history and stories.





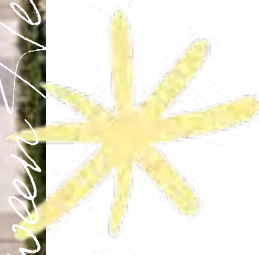

The Architecture

The highest, the Cristale wing, overlooks the peak and appears to hover above the void. Lower down, in the Azur wing, suites are hewn into the rock itself - an architectural feat - while the Corniche, with its immaculate hues, follows the natural curves of the landscape.

Its pure lines, carved into the cliffside, are the work of Jean-Michel Wilmotte. A close embrace with the rock, where 65 rooms (including 24 suites) reach towards the sky, offering the perfect vantage point to admire the dance of the seagulls. Set on rugged terrain, the architect defies the rocky promontory, paying particular attention to the views from each room.







The Design *Harmony* Of Creators



To craft its setting, The Maybourne Riviera brings together internationally renowned architects and designers, including Bryan O'Sullivan's architectural firm, André Fu, and the London-based studio Rigby & Rigby.

Michelle Wu, Artistic Director for Maybourne, creates harmony between these diverse worlds through a masterful play of materials, colours, and textures, alongside her curated selection of artworks.

"What makes the Riviera unique is its spectacular setting and the views it offers," she says, emphasising how "the Mediterranean light and the vistas over the sea, France, and Italy" have inspired the interiors.

Art holds a central place in the hotel - from the lobby adorned with a work by Le Corbusier to pieces by the artist JR scattered across the floors, as well as photographs by Edward Quinn, a longtime friend of Pablo Picasso and the jet set of that era.





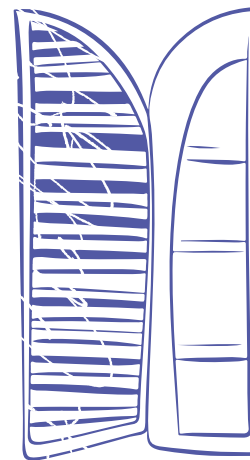


Between sky and sea

A timeless moment

Suites *and Studios* Breathtaking *Sea Views*

From sleek, minimalist suites to a duplex with an infinity pool, and cosy studios where oak takes centre stage, the rooms at The Maybourne Riviera blend seamlessly with nature.



The gaze drifts over the waves or the pine trees of a lush garden, as the boundaries between inside and out gently dissolve.





A Daydream in the Mediterranean

Drawing on their experience in yacht design, the London-based architecture studio Rigby & Rigby has crafted the studios and suites of the Cristal wing. They shape clean lines, sculptural curves, and angles to create a setting perfectly in harmony with the sea just metres below.

"The layering of textures and the subtle use of colour in our bespoke furniture contribute to a unique sensation, an uninterrupted connection between the room and the sea," explain the designers from Bryan O'Sullivan Studio.

Inspired by the work of Eileen Gray (whose iconic E-1027 villa is visible from the hotel) by the surrounding nature, and by the sea views, they play with undulating curves.

The interior seems to pulse with the rhythm of the Mediterranean waves, a striking contrast to the sharp, angular exterior architecture, they add.

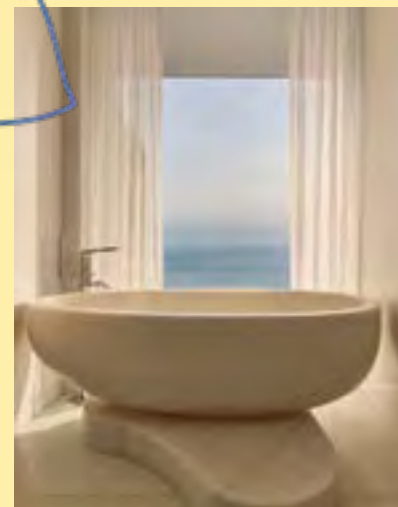


In a Sea View Suite on the Corniche, you'll find a white marble bathtub inspired by sculptor Constantin Brâncuși, as envisioned by André Fu. "I wanted to create a pure expression of form with an organic freestanding tub - carved from a solid block of white marble," he explains, adding why it's placed by the window facing the ocean: "It's about creating a sense of serenity and paying tribute to the infinite view offered by The Maybourne Riviera." Ranging from 40 to 220 square metres, the 65 suites and studios embody perfection.



On the first floor, unique pieces by Bryan O'Sullivan Studio find their place - oak panels, bespoke furniture, and subtly sculpted glass tabletops. This powerful imagination evokes natural materials, intuitive shapes, woodwork, curves, and pastel hues.

All suites and studios feature terraces with sea views, where the gaze stretches from Roquebrune Bay to Monaco's harbour; in harmony with the waves, the feeling of bliss is complete.

A true expression of Mediterranean living, the Signature Suites offer a rare experience between sky, sea, and light. Designed as suspended havens, they celebrate both the beauty of the landscape and the luxury of fine detail.

On the top floor, the Horizon Suite overlooks the Mediterranean, embracing the Riviera from east to west. Its panoramic terrace, sun-drenched living areas, and three flexible bedrooms make it the perfect place to gather with family or friends.

Inspired by the splendour of the Côte d'Azur, the duplex Azur Suite combines generous volumes, contemporary design, and spectacular views from its two terraces.

The Panoramic Suites (one or two bedrooms) celebrate curves, light, and the horizon. Their understated elegance opens onto terraces with uninterrupted views stretching from Italy to Monaco.

Finally, the Bleu Infini Suite, with its private infinity pool, embodies the ultimate escape. Like a living work of art, it offers a continuous dialogue between architecture, nature, and emotion.

A stay in a Signature Suite includes a selection of exclusive privileges: Meet & Greet airport service, guaranteed early check-in and late check-out, a private sunset cruise on the Mediterranean aboard a Riva boat, as well as a personalised consultation at Surrenne Riviera followed by a 60-minute signature massage. abc kitchens *riviera*

From New York to the Côte d'Azur, Michelin-starred Chef Jean-Georges Vongerichten brings his iconic abc kitchens concept to the hotel rooftop this summer. Inspired by his famed Manhattan venues - abc kitchen, abcV, and abc cocina - the restaurant offers bold, locavore, and plant-forward cuisine elevated to new heights.

With breathtaking panoramic views over the Mediterranean and Cap-Martin, abc kitchens riviera celebrates fresh, sustainable, and regional produce through inventive, shareable dishes.

True to his "market-to-table" philosophy, Jean-Georges highlights organic ingredients. The menu focuses on the natural richness of each element: light broths, vegetable juices, herb vinaigrettes, roasted vegetables, and vibrant plates take centre stage.

Signature dishes include the kale salad with serrano chili and the grilled octopus served with a cashew romesco sauce. The menu showcases Mediterranean and vegetarian flavours with a modern, refined touch.

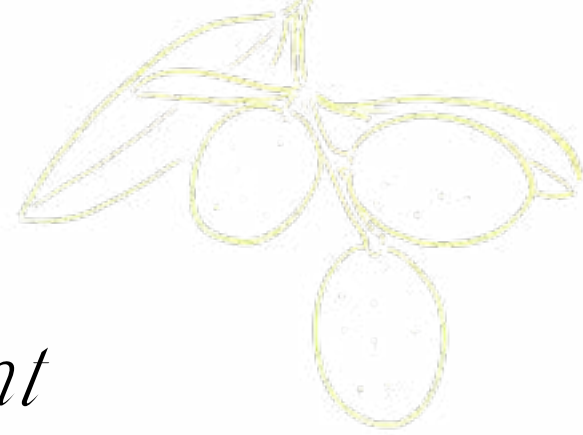

Chef Guillaume Boumati infuses Restaurant Riviera with a cuisine of delicate refinement, guided by the seasons and inspired by the Mediterranean. Each plate becomes a moment of perfect balance and brilliance.

Under his direction, Restaurant Riviera reveals itself as a stage for culinary emotions, where the radiance of flavors, the precision of textures, and the elegance of movement resonate in perfect harmony.

Reflecting the turquoise hues of the sea, the décor by Bryan O'Sullivan Studio blurs the boundaries between inside and out. A palette of blue shades evokes the tones of the Mediterranean and the French Riviera - from the blue-grey mosaic flooring and cerulean seating to the glass tabletop.



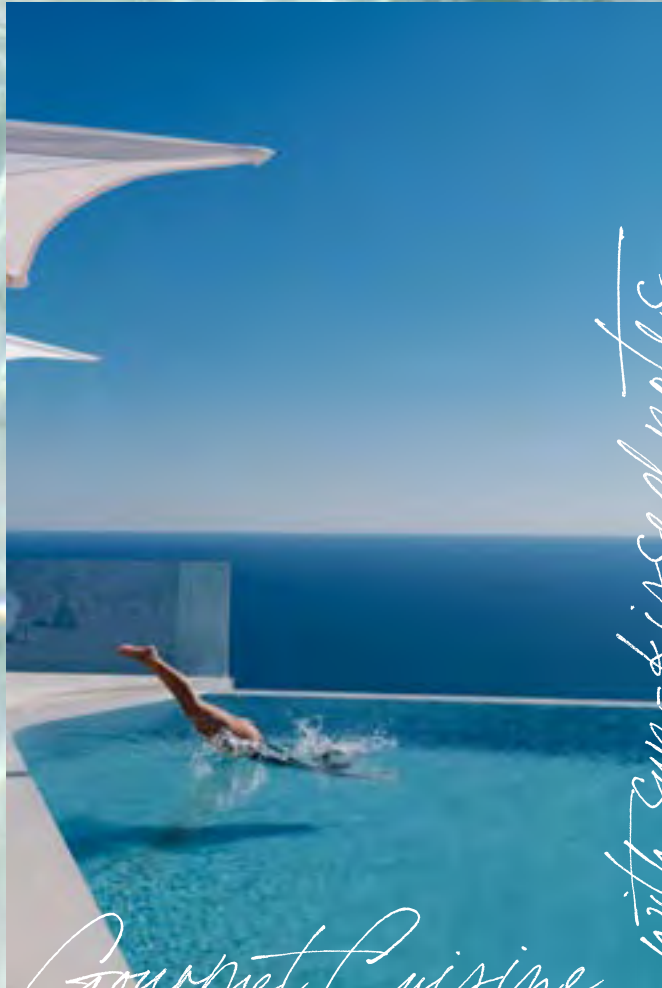
La *Piscine*

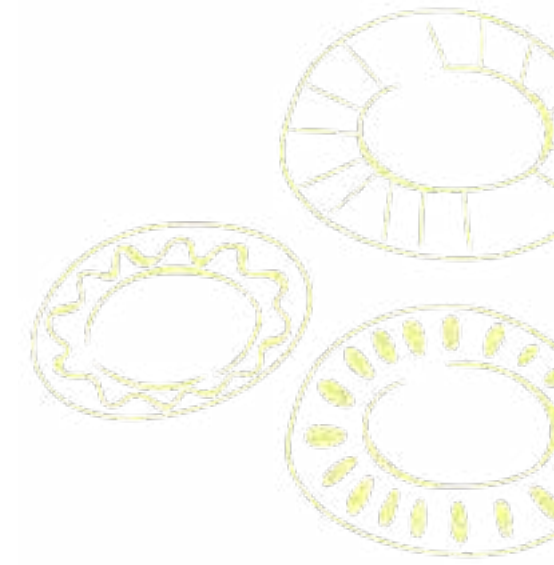
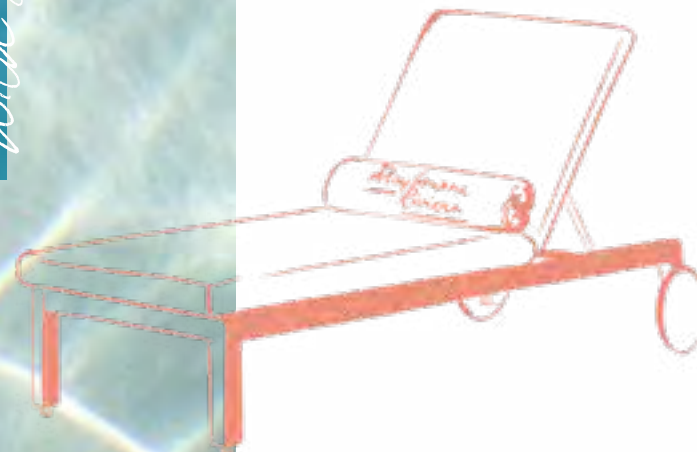
Pizzas hold a special place on the menu. Nunzio, the Neapolitan pizza chef, is the undisputed master. With over twelve years of experience, he crafts each pizza respecting the traditions of his homeland. His Margherita, made according to the classic recipe, remains a firm favourite.

For something sweet, the desserts combine freshness and creativity: signature sundaes featuring Fior di Latte ice cream, frozen mochis, and kakigori flavoured with hibiscus flower or with melon basil.

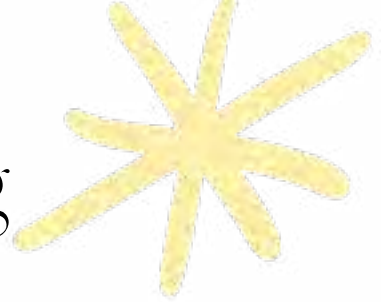

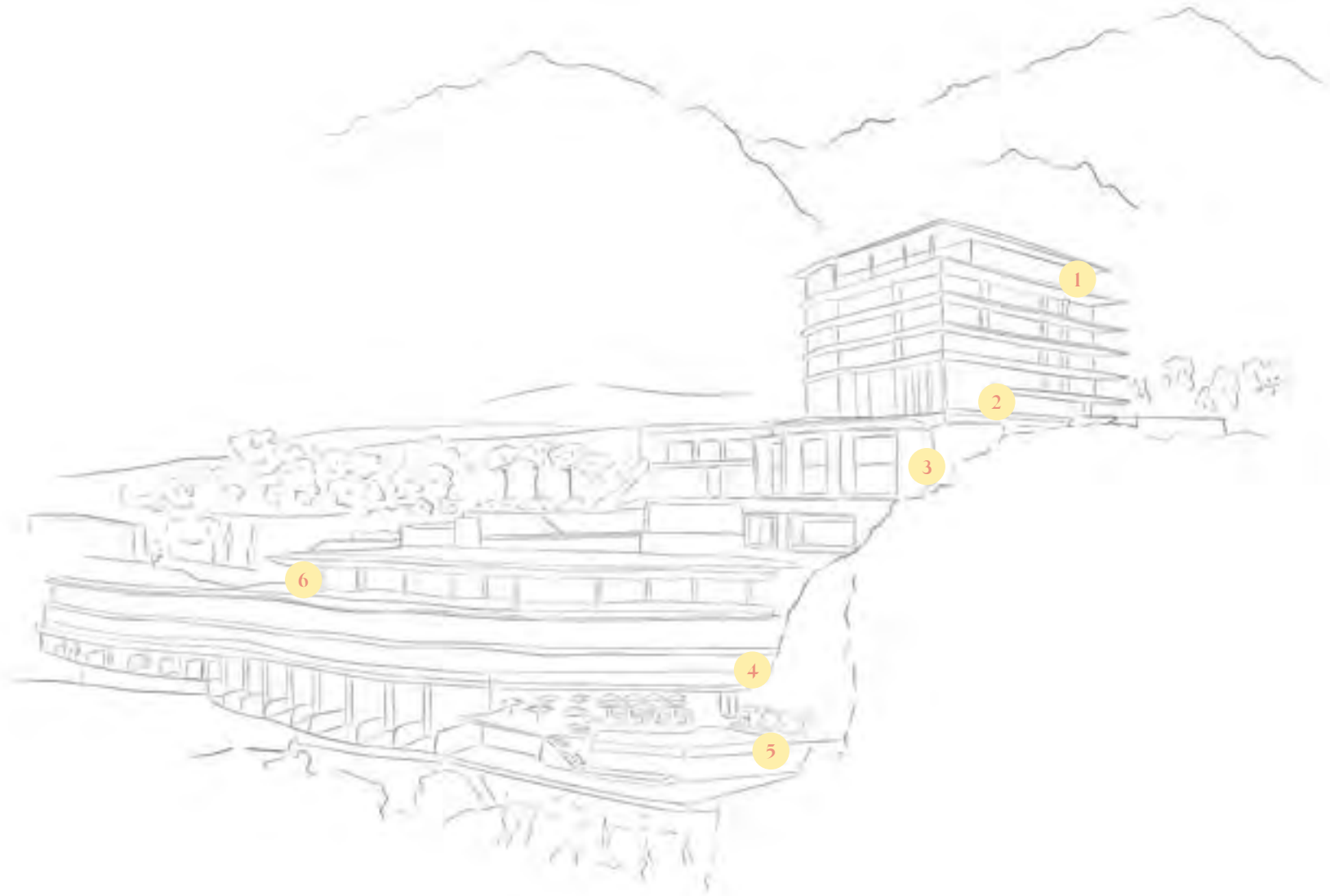
